Keynote Speakers:

Jay Phoenix Singh, PhD, is a Fulbright Scholar, faculty at both UPenn as well as Cambridge, and the internationally award-winning Founder of the Global Institute of Forensic Research (successful 2017 exit as CEO). Author of over 85 peer-reviewed articles and books, he completed his graduate doctoral studies in psychiatry at the University of Oxford and clinical psychology at Universitat Konstanz.



An inspiring and charismatic coach who uses evidence-based practices to improve the lives of graduate students, post doctoral fellows, and academics of all ages as well as executives, Dr. Singh is the only psychology professor to have lectured for all eight Ivy League universities as well as both Oxford and Cambridge.

Gaelin Elmore is a former college football player at the University of Minnesota. He played in over 38 games in just three years for the Gophers before graduating early with a degree in Communication Studies. He then played his final year at East Carolina University while pursuing his masters degree. Gaelin played one year for the Pirates before a short stint in the NFL with the Cincinnati Bengals.



Gaelin is now a professional in the nonprofit sector and currently serves as the Director of Coaching for the Forgotten Initiative, a faith-based nonprofit that helps launch ministries that serve the foster care community. Gaelin, a former foster youth himself, is also a professional keynote speaker, consultant and workshop facilitator. His aim is to revise the way the world values and responds to adversity, specifically in the child welfare space.
